Minecraft is a video game about breaking and placing blocks. Players (named Steve) can work together to create wonderful, imaginative things in a 3D world. When the sun sets it's best to be in your home, because the night creatures (creepers) will be looking for you. Other activities in the game include exploration, gathering resources and crafting. Multiple players can even interact and communicate with each other in a single world.

Schedule of Events

Online Play

Play the Minecraft game on our computers. If you have not played before, it's easy to learn. An account is needed, with parent permission. Gaming will be in the Tech Lab on second floor, the teen computers and the gaming room in the Union.

Live Action Play

Help build a live action Minecraft world, then destroy it and start all over. This interactive version of Minecraft will enable you to be creative and build structures with actual blocks. Make sure you avoid the creeperssssss when the sun goes down. You will be able to explore the library by completing a series of tasks described on the back of this page. Live action play will be in Beems A and B.

Crafting and Snacks

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Exploration

Hello Steve. You have been dropped into the world of Minecraft. Your job is to survive the day and avoid the creeperssssss.... Follow these directions and have fun!

Make your Chest: At Minecraft Start pick up a chest picture and a brown paper bag. Glue the chest picture on your bag. Write your name on your chest. This is yours to keep and will hold all of your tools and treasures from today. Feel free to explore before starting your adventure, but once you begin, please follow the steps in order.

Mine your Wood: Look at the number on the bottom of your chest. Find that number on the tree bark on the wall. Put it in your chest then go to the Shovel Crafting Cart.

Make a Tool: Pick up materials for a shovel and make it at the crafting table. Put it in your chest.

Go Exploring: Go find 1 Minecraft magnet in the library. Put it in your chest.

Make a Tool: Go to the Pickaxe Crafting Cart and pick up materials for a pickaxe tool. Make it at the crafting table. Put it in your chest.

Go Exploring: Go find 1 more magnet in the library. It has to be in a different location than the first one you found. Put it in your chest.

Make a Tool: Go to the Sword Crafting Cart and pick up materials to make a sword. Make it at the crafting table. Put it in your chest.

Go to the programming room in children's and pick up materials to make a fishing pole. Make it and catch a fish with it. Put them in your chest.

Enjoy a snack.

Congratulations Steve! You survived a day in Minecraft.

You can do the other activities in the programming room or go back to live action play in Beems.

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
